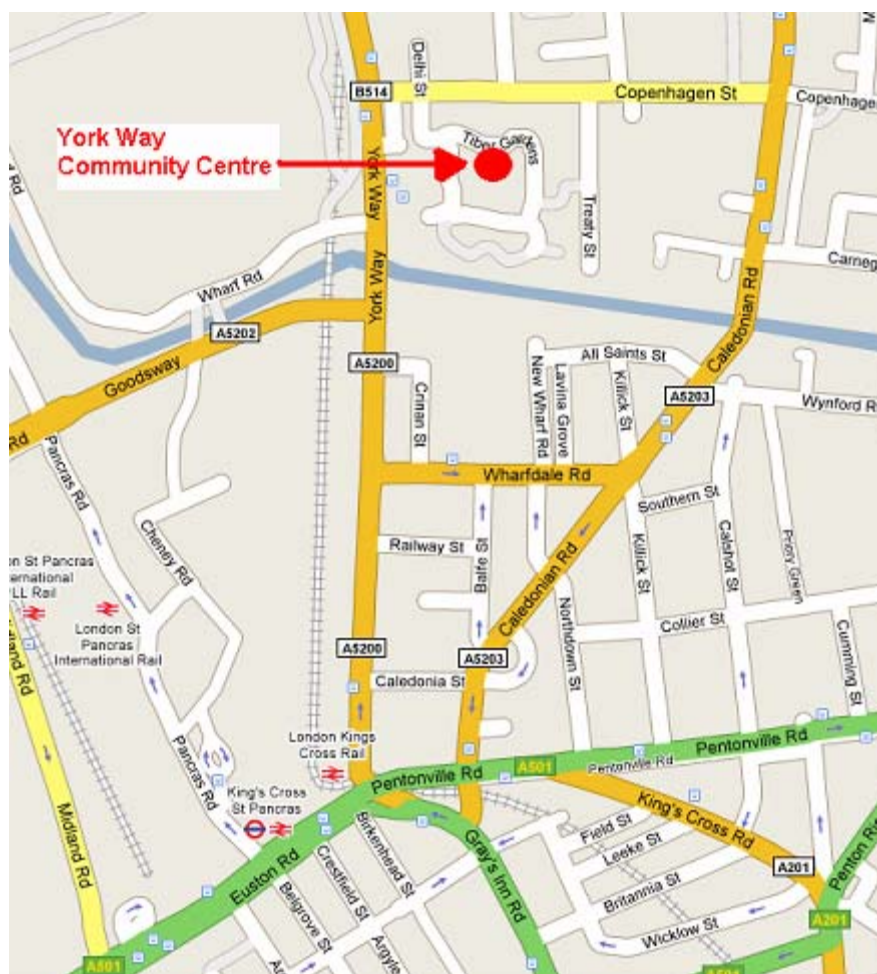

### Workshop Location Plan:



- Bus 390 from King's Cross runs via York Way, stopping near the junction of York Way / Copenhagen Street. From here it is a 3 minute walk.
- Buses 17, 91 and 259 from King's Cross run via Caledonian Road stopping near the junction of Caledonian Road / Copenhagen Street. From here it is a 10 minute walk.
- Bus 274 from Angel runs via the east end of Copenhagen Street, stopping near the junction of Caledonian Road / Copenhagen Street. From here it is a 10 minute walk.
